What NOT to bring:

- Animals / Insects
- Knives, Firearms, Fireworks
- Valuables of any kind
- Personal Snacks

- Sunscreen
- Skateboard (skate park on campus)
- Spirit Wear (bandanas, face paint, etc. team color will be announced once we receive it)

CAMP RULES:

- Campers must attend all scheduled or special group functions.
- No Camper is allowed to leave the camp ground unless authorized by the Camp Director.
- Any Camper damaging property **WILL** be held responsible and **CHARGED** for the damages.
- No one may be excused from services unless accompanied by a leader.
- Members of the opposite sex are not allowed in the other dorm/cabin at any time.
- No public displays of affection.
- All Campers must be in their respective cabin/dorm at lights out.
- There will be no practical jokes at other Camper's expense. Chaperones will strictly enforce this rule.
- Absolutely no explicit music, smoking, drugs, alcohol or vulgar language will be tolerated.
- Please notify YTH staff of any info concerning physical disorders, (i.e. epilepsy, nervous disorders, bed wetter, or allergies) so that your child may receive proper care.
- All medications must be turned in at Camp Registration along with instructions. Medicine must be kept in original pill bottles when turned in.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- We're asking that students practice modesty when choosing what to wear at Summer Camp. Please partner with us by encouraging them to be modest as well.
- Modest one-piece bathing suits are preferred for young ladies in the pool area.
- Street clothes need to be worn to and from the Pool area.
- All Campers will be subject to rules while at camp. Any infraction of the rules is punishable by expulsion from camp, if the leadership deems necessary. Parents will be called to escort you home if you are expelled from camp.
